**1. Discussion Regarding the 2022 SPLOST**

Vice-Chairman Karwacki opened giving County Manager Zoucks the floor.

County Manager Zoucks stated that this meeting is required by law to discuss capital projects for presentations to the public in 2022 SPLOST referendum. The amount of the SPLOST based on calculations by County Manager Zoucks and City Manager Richard Braun, Jr. is \$11,520,000.00 million with a split of 80% (\$9,216,000.00) County and 20% (\$2,304,000.00) City. Discussion was held between the two board.
